



Procedure for washing calf feeding equipment

1. Rinse equipment completely with lukewarm (**not** hot) water to remove milk residue.
2. Use hot water that is over 120 °F containing both soap and chlorine to wash equipment. Scrub the equipment completely using a brush.
3. Rinse the equipment using an acid rinse.
4. Let dry (invert all containers so that they drip, dry. **Do not** stack on the floor.)
5. Another acid rinse can be used just before feeding, to insure sanitary equipment.
